Re: **Motion for discovery and inspection**

The Company respectfully announces that on July 11, 2019 a motion was received at the Company’s offices which was filed on July 9, 2019 to the Tel Aviv District Court (the Economic Department) against the Company, Isramco Negev 2, LP, Alon Natural Gas Exploration Ltd. and Dor Gas Exploration, LP (together, the “**Respondents**”) for discovery and inspection pursuant to Section 198A to the Companies Law, 5759-1999 (the “**Motion**”), whose purpose, according to what is stated therein, is to require the Company to transfer to the petitioner various documents specified in the Motion, with respect to the competitive process publicly announced by the Israel Electric Corporation (the “**IEC**”) for the supply of natural gas (the “**Competitive Process**”)¹, which will enable the petitioner to examine the filing of a derivative suit against officers and position holders who, he claims, caused, through their illegal and non-competitive conduct, damage to the Respondents as a result of the Tamar partners not winning the Competitive Process.

The Company intends to study the details of the Motion, with the aid of its legal counsel, and to formulate its response accordingly.
